Featuring commentary by historian James Ponce on the history of the famous shopping destination, as well as the unique architecture and historical significance of many of its legendary landmarks, the tours will be held on select Wednesdays and Saturdays throughout the year. Proclaimed as Palm Beach's only Two Legged Historical

Landmark' by the Palm Beach Town Council in 1996, Ponce was born in St. Augustine and can trace his early Spanish ancestry in Florida back to 1594. More than 49 years ago, Ponce began his Palm Beach career at The Breakers. Historical Walking Tours of Wonderful Worth Avenue will include visits to Via Parigi and Via Mizner.
