'What stood out to the judges was that Peaches was not only a dedicated therapy dog but that she was also a top dog model," said a spokesperson for America's Top Dog Model. "They also felt that her contest photograph well depicted both of these roles and best represented the contest theme."

Peaches is a graduate of Share A Pet, a Ft. Lauderdale, Fla. based program that provides certification and insurance for pet owners who use their pets in therapy work.

'Peaches has brought so much joy to children in homeless shelters and hospitals," said Claire Spielman.

"She also visits patients in nursing homes, but she seems happiest working with children," Spielman added

"We felt Peaches was a perfect match for pet therapy," she said, "as she is small, bright, obedient, and irresistible. When her little yest goes on, she knows its time to visit the kids."
