Sharon Dodsworth, of Leesburg, first laid eyes on Royal in June 2014 at the Humane Society/SPCA of Sumter County. She was actively looking for another best friend after her Labrador retriever, Jake, had passed away a month prior.

Before his name was changed to Royal, he was known as "Rags" at the Humane Society because he looked like a dirty

"As soon as I saw him, I knew he was the one I wanted," Dodsworth said.

After she adopted him, she decided to change his name to Royal Jasper because she was going to treat him like royalty, and the colors of his coat match the colors of a jasper stone.

It did not take long before he transformed into a superstar and became known as "Royal Rags to Riches."

Dodsworth started buying him outfits, and she said Royal loved to dress up and sit like he was posing for the camera.

With a full wardrobe of costumes, Royal participates in all the local parades and contests Dodsworth can find, such as the Strut Your Mutt charity dog walk in The Villages and Leesburg's Mardi Gras celebration.

In March, they participated in a pet parade and contest with America's Top Dog Model, a brand that includes a national contest, annual calendar and online store.

Dodsworth and Royal went to the organization's casting call in April, and Royal was a finalist out of about

"Adorable Royal wowed the judges with his stage presence as he paraded across the stage on his toy horse," said Jo Jo Harder, the CEO and creator of America's Top Dog Model. "We also love seeing the interaction between him and his mom, Sharon. It is apparent that they are very close.

Dodsworth wasn't always a dog person. In fact, she was scared of dogs after she was bitten by a German shepherd as a child.

But she decided to get her first dog in 1999 from the Lake County Animal Shelter. To overcome her fear, she got Nellie, a German shepherd mix.

Jake came along a few years later, and when they both passed away, Dodsworth said she couldn't stand being without a dog.

Now, she goes everywhere she can with Royal, and passersby can't help but stop to take photos.

For now, she continues to let Royal spread love throughout the community.


