A dog from Rancho Cucamonga is the winner of America's Top Dog Model 2020 "Fairy Tails" Contest, chosen for her portrayal of a retelling of a classic fairytale.

That dog is Shai, a 1½-year-old Afghan hound who is Terre Moshe's service dog.

Shai's winning photo, taken by Kimberly Saxelby, portrays Shai as "Big Red Riding Hood," a fairy "tail" created by Moshe. Her retelling of "Little Red Riding Hood" will be published in America's Top Dog Model Book of Fairy Tails, according to a news release. The book will also include the fairy "tails" of the 11 finalists.

Shai came into Moshe's life after her Afghan hound Adar died. Friends searched for Afghan hounds for her, and found Shai in Canada.

Shai has passed her Canine Good Citizen advanced training and she loves to model, according to the news release.

America's Top Dog Model's mission is to celebrate dogs that make a difference in people's lives, according to the news release. The national contest was launched in 2005.
